"I spent hours holding a surveying stick as my father would lay out a home. I worked with my father in every aspect of the building process from mixing concrete by hand to designing a home. I had the opportunity to ask questions of the best builder in the business. That is the kind of hands-on education you don't gain from reading books in school.

"I am eternally grateful for the many lessons my father has taught me about meeting the highest of standards in building homes, as well as working with people and running a business," adds Dominick Paragano. "Although my father retired after working 50plus years of his life as a builder, I can still count on him to give the white glove treatment whenever I invite him to look at my work. "Every customer I have built a home for in the last four years has at least one of these porches on their home. Some customers have enjoyed these porches so much, that they wind up with two or three porches." Covered porches can be enjoyed by all family members and serve as inviting settings for entertaining.

Paragano notes that today's buyer tends to want a more traditional home. People are more likely to want a two-story colonial home with a master suite and sitting area, rather than a first-floor master bedroom ranch. Columns are popular, as well as nine-foot
